Lost Forest Cabins is located deep within Sam Houston National Forest. Due to the remote nature of the property, please follow these instructions carefully.

From Houston/Dallas:

1. Take I-45 North/South towards Conroe.
2. Exit 102 for FM 1375 and continue west for approximately 8 miles.
3. Turn right on to FM 149 N and continue 0.8 miles
4. Turn right toward Grissom Rd and continue 0.6 miles
5. Look for Forest Service Road on your right, this is a gravel road.

You will find the following sign. Turn here.

We are located approximately 2.4 miles off the main paved road via a Forest Service gravel road. Please drive slowly and carefully.

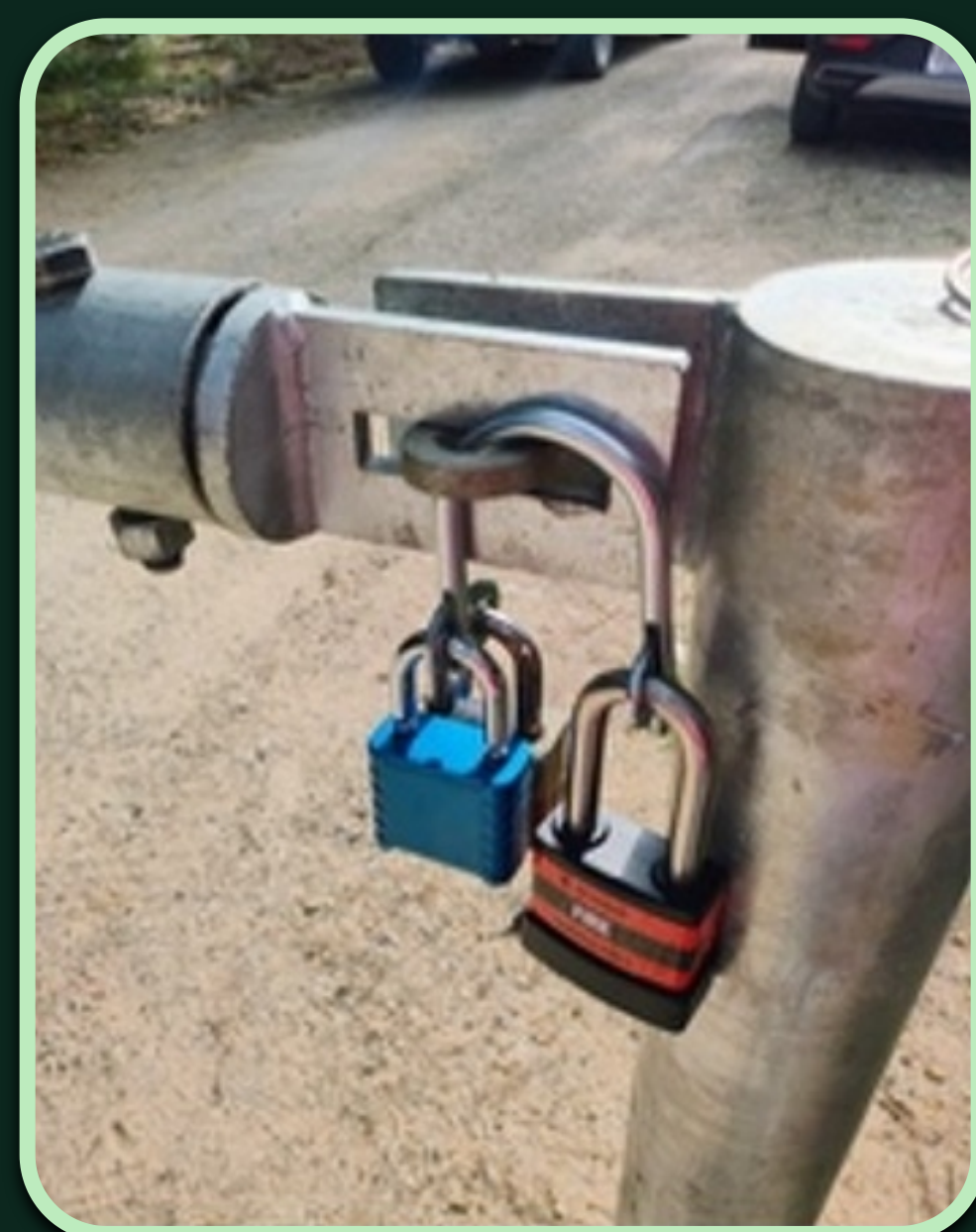

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Forest Road Lock

At the entrance to the forest road (before driving the 2.4-mile gravel path to the cabins), you'll encounter a metal gate BLUE combination lock.



You will receive the combination code via text/email 24 hours before check-in.
Open the gate using the code provided and re-lock it behind you to keep the area secure.
Drive 2.4 miles along the gravel road to reach the main property gate.
You will see this sign:

2. Main Property Gate (Keypad)

The next gate is equipped with a keypad access system.



Enter the 4-digit access code.

The gate will automatically open and close behind you.

The gate opens outward toward your vehicle.

Please do not approach too closely until it has fully opened.

To exit the property, locate the 'EXIT' button near the gate.

Press the button to open the gate before driving out.

3. Cabin Door Lockbox

Each cabin has a lockbox located near the main entrance with the key inside.



You will receive the lockbox code along with your check-in instructions.

Open the lockbox, retrieve the key, and keep it safe during your stay.

Please return the key to the lockbox and scramble the code upon check-out.

Parking

- ✓ Please Park only on the gravel pad designated for your cabin.
- ✓ Do not park on grass, trails, or forested areas.
- ✓ Each cabin allows up to 2 vehicles.
- ✓ For oversized vehicles or trailers, contact us ahead of time for guidance.

Emergency Items Location

For your safety and peace of mind, the following emergency items are available in the cabin:

Fire Extinguisher: Mounted on the living room wall.

Emergency Lantern: Located on the shelves in the first-floor bedroom.

First Aid Kit: Also placed on the shelves in the first-floor bedroom.

Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with these locations upon arrival.

Filtered & Safe Drinking Water

Your health and comfort are important to us. That's why all cabins are equipped with high-quality water filters to ensure the tap water is clean, fresh, and safe to drink.

Feel free to fill up your bottles or enjoy a glass straight from the kitchen faucet-no need to bring bottled water!

Shower Use & Comfort

We've designed the shower to offer you a relaxing and refreshing experience during your stay. To help you get the perfect temperature and water pressure, please note the simple three-knob system:

Left knob – Controls the hot water

Center knob – Adjusts the water pressure

Right knob – Controls the cold water

Feel free to adjust both the hot and cold knobs to find your ideal temperature. Enjoy your shower!

Here's what you'll find:

- ✓ Full-size refrigerator
- ✓ Induction cooktop & induction-compatible cookware
- ✓ Microwave and convection oven
- ✓ Baking sheets
- ✓ Coffee maker and a dedicated coffee and tea station (with coffee, tea, and sugar)
- ✓ Electric kettle & toaster
- ✓ Blender
- ✓ A full range of cooking utensils: spatula, slotted spoon, serving spoon, whisk, tongs, ladle, peeler, can opener, kitchen scissors, measuring cups, strainer, cutting board, knife set, potato masher, mixing bowl, grater
- ✓ Dinnerware for six, including plates, bowls, cutlery, cups and mugs
- ✓ Wine glasses & corkscrew
- ✓ Spices, salt and pepper
- ✓ Full-size sink with dish drying rack
- ✓ BBQ utensil set: tongs, spatula, grill fork, basting brush, grill brush, skewers
- ✓ Eco-friendly dish soap & basic cleaning supplies

Pots and pans have removable handles to save space.

Here's how to use them properly:

1. Align the handle with the metal base
2. Press the button or lever until it clicks
3. Make sure it's securely attached before lifting
4. To remove, press the release button and pull gently

Appliances instructions

The cabin is equipped with modern appliances to make your stay as comfortable as possible. Below you'll find simple, step-by-step instructions for each one. Please follow these guidelines to ensure safe use and optimal performance.

Washer

Appliance: LG WashTower Laundry Center (Top Section)

How to Use:

1. Open the front door and load your clothes (do not overfill).
2. Add detergent and fabric softener to the designated compartments in the drawer.
3. Close the door and choose a wash cycle from the center panel.
4. Press Start/Pause to begin the wash.
5. Wait for the cycle to finish and the door to unlock.
6. Remove clothes promptly to prevent odors and wrinkles.

Dryer

Appliance: LG WashTower Laundry Center (Bottom Section)

How to Use:

1. Clean the lint filter before each use.
2. Load damp clothes (avoid overloading).
3. Choose a drying cycle: Normal, Delicates, Quick, etc.
4. Press Start/Pause to begin drying.
5. Once complete, remove clothes promptly.
6. Clean the lint filter again if needed for best performance.

Cooktop

Note: This is an induction cooktop and only works with magnetic-base cookware (provided in the cabin).

How to Use:

1. Unlock the cooktop by pressing the lock button for 5 seconds.
2. Power on by placing cookware on the burner and tapping the power icon.
3. Select a burner by tapping its icon on the panel.
4. Set heat level using the + / – buttons or slider.
5. Turn off by tapping the power icon again. Wait until the residual heat indicator turns off before touching or cleaning.

 Only use induction-compatible cookware.

Coffee Maker

Appliance: Mr. Coffee 12-Cup Brewer

How to Use:

1. Fill the water reservoir (up to 12 cups).
2. Insert a paper filter and add ground coffee to the brew basket.
3. Close the lid and press ON.
4. Wait for the brewing to finish or use the auto-pause feature to pour early.

 Turn off the machine after use. Discard the used filter and clean the pot.

Convection Microwave Oven

Appliance: ZLINE Microwave + Convection Oven Combo

Microwave mode:

1. Open the door by pressing the button or pulling gently.
2. Place food inside using only microwave-safe containers.
3. Set the cooking time and power level via the touch panel.
4. Press Start and wait for the cycle to finish.

 Do not use metal utensils or foil in microwave mode.

Convection Oven Mode (for baking):

1. Select “Convection” mode on the panel.
2. Preheat if needed (the display will indicate when ready).
3. Place food on a heat-safe tray or rack (not on the glass turntable).
4. Set temperature and time, then press Start.

 Metal trays are safe in convection mode, but never in microwave mode.
Baking sheets provided for your convenience.

Thermostat Remote: Mounted on the main wall upstairs.

- ✓ Use **Cool**, **Heat**, or **Auto** modes to control cabin temperature.
- ✓ Adjust fan speed and temperature as needed for comfort.

Welcome to **Lost Forest Cabins**, your peaceful retreat in the heart of Sam Houston National Forest. To help ensure a safe, respectful, and relaxing experience for all guests and to preserve the beauty of the forest, please take a moment to review the following Indoor and Outdoor Rules.

By staying with us, you acknowledge your agreement to these policies. Your cooperation is truly appreciated!

Check-In & Check-Out

Check-in: From 3:00 PM

Check-out: By 12:00 PM (noon)

Early check-in/late check-out may be requested and is subject to availability and added fee.

Indoor Rules

Bunk Bed Safety: If the property includes bunk beds, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks associated with their use, especially for children. By staying at the property, you agree to supervise children at all times when using the bunk beds and to ensure they follow all safety instructions.

Before checking out, please:

- ✓ Ensure **cooktop and appliances are turned off.**
- ✓ Confirm **campfires are fully extinguished.**
- ✓ **Turn off all lights.**
- ✓ **Close all windows and doors.**
- ✓ **Leave the keys in the lockbox.**

Cleaning Expectations

- ✓ Wash all dishes before you leave.
You may leave them to dry on the rack or return them to where you found them.
- ✓ Place used towels and linens on the floor of the laundry room.
- ✓ Empty the refrigerator and do not leave any food behind.

Trash Disposal

- ✓ Bag all trash and place it in the **outdoor dumpster** located by the gate.
- ✓ **Do not leave food or trash outside** as it attracts wildlife.
- ✓ Please use the compost bin in the kitchen for all your food waste.

Indoor Rules

Fire Safety System

- ✓ **No candles, incense, smoking, or open flames** are allowed inside the cabin.
- ✓ Cabins are equipped with **automatic fire sprinkler systems** that activate with heat or flames.
- ✓ **Indoor smoke (even from cooking)** can trigger alarms or sprinklers, please ventilate properly.

Quiet Hours

10:00 PM to 7:00 AM. Please avoid loud music, parties, or disruptive behavior during these hours to preserve the serenity of the forest.

Outdoor Rules

Access & Parking

- ✓ Our property is accessed via a 2.4-mile Forest Service Road, open only to street-legal vehicles.
- ✓ If you're bringing other vehicle types (e.g. ATVs or dirt bikes), please check Sam Houston National Forest regulations for sticker or permit requirements.
- ✓ Parking on the Forest Service Road is strictly prohibited.

Pet Policy

- ✓ Pets are welcome **only in designated pet-friendly cabins** (max 2 per cabin).
- ✓ **Always leash pets outdoors** and clean up after them.
- ✓ Pet-related damage may result in added charges.

Pond Safety

- ✓ **No swimming** in the pond.
- ✓ Children must be **supervised by an adult** near water.
- ✓ Kayaks and paddleboards **are used at your own risk, and life jackets are required.**

Fishing

- ✓ Fishing is allowed on-site and in nearby lakes.
- ✓ **Catch-and-release only** in our private pond.

Hunting, Firearms & Fireworks

- ✓ **Hunting is strictly prohibited** on Lost Forest Cabins property.
- ✓ **Open carry firearms are not permitted** on-site.
- ✓ **Fireworks are not allowed under any circumstances.**
- ✓ Some nearby areas allow seasonal hunting.
Wear high-visibility clothing and check dates via:

Outdoor Fire Safety

- ✓ **Campfires only in designated fire pits.**
- ✓ Fires must be **attended at all times and fully extinguished** after use.
- ✓ Smoking and open flames are **not permitted** on decks.

Wildlife Etiquette

- ✓ **Do not feed or approach wildlife.**
- ✓ Feel free to enjoy birdwatching.
You might spot bald eagles or the red-cockaded woodpecker!

Equestrian Access

- ✓ Horses are welcome on designated forest trails.
- ✓ **A negative Coggins Test** must be carried at all times.
- ✓ Horse trailers may be parked in designated areas.

Nature Sounds (Don't Panic!)

Expect some unusual forest sounds. They're perfectly normal:

- ✓ Wind in trees — may sound like whispers.
- ✓ Cracking branches — usually deer or raccoons.
- ✓ Owl hoots and bird calls — common at night.
- ✓ Frogs and insects — surprisingly loud after dark.
- ✓ Rustling bushes — often small animals like armadillos or squirrels.

Sustainability Guidelines

Help us protect the forest:

- ✓ **Minimize disposable waste**, we provide reusable kitchenware and supplies.
- ✓ **Do not leave food, wrappers, or personal items outside** to avoid attracting wildlife.
- ✓ Use compost bin whenever possible.

Weather, Energy & Water Conservation

- ✓ During storms, avoid trees and open water; follow emergency guidelines.
- ✓ Turn off lights and water when not in use to conserve resources and protect the environment.

Off-Highway Vehicles (OHVs)

- ✓ OHVs may be used only on **designated trails** in the National Forest with a **valid Texas OHV decal**.
- ✓ OHV use is not allowed on Lost Forest Cabins property.
